

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History and Background


- Request from the Veteran Integrated Service Network (VISN) 22, which includes Arizona
 - Notified of veterans within the Show Low area who are unable to reach the designated pickup locations to receive transportation assistance to their medical appointments within their local (or further, if needed) clinics
- Be Connected team travelled to area to discuss issues with veterans
 - Navigator who assisted is now coordinator assisting in transportation project and working with partners to contribute to the mission


Plan of Action

- Provide acute support to address immediate needs while building a system for long-term resolution
- Develop a program, prepare for launch and anticipate longevity
- Connect with Be Connected partners to assist--NARBHA Institute and Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG)



Plan of Action

- Facilitate transportation opportunities through volunteer drivers
- Pilot specific areas across Northern Arizona
- Organize procedures for onboarding volunteers, connecting with veterans, their families and caregivers and tracking impact





PIVOT! PIV-OT!





Volunteer driver program to bring essentials to the veteran community (e.g. food, appts, etc.).

 Received a separate grant to address COVID-related issues, primarily food insecurity



- Get food to veterans & their families who need it, through the delivery program
- Collect data on these specific populations to inform continued and future projects



Volunteer driver program to bring essentials to the veteran community (e.g. food, appts, etc.).

Current: COVID relief food insecurity project to identify food and transportation insecurities in veteran households in project areas.

- Served **118 households; 293 veterans & family members**, mostly in rural and tribal communities.
- **26.2%** reported need for ongoing food assistance.
- **36.4%** of those with recurring food needs reported consistent transportation insecurity.

Next: Partnering with local partners to serve the high-risk populations identified through the food insecurity effort and utilize volunteer drivers and navigators to facilitate connection between service providers and recipients.



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
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Focus Communities

- Consistent Support to Food Insecure Veterans across Northern AZ
 - Including wraparound Be Connected support
- 2nd Phase of COVID Community Support
 Replicating Northern AZ pilot in Southern AZ
- Statewide Food Pop-up Project
- VA Food Pantry and Event Coordination
- ADVS Transportation Survey
 - **50%** of respondents have reported at least one barrier to consistent transportation.
