

#### **ESTIMATED NEED**





# **TOHONO O'ODHAM NATION**

- Population enrolled members: 35,898 (A. Lewis, personal communication, March 20, 2023)
  - 1500 enrolled with Mexico address
  - 11 district/Sonora Mexico
- Size: 2.8 million acres (Approximately size of Connecticut)
- 62 Miles of AZ/Mexico Border on the Nation's Land
- 60% members living off the Nation
- 40% on the Nation







# PASCUA YAQUI TRIBE



- Population: Approximately 21,233 Tribal Members (NCAI, 2001-2022)
- Population: Pascua Pueblo Yaqui Reservation and Off-Reservation Trust Land: 3,742 Tribal Members (City Population, 2022).
- 5 Tribal Communities:
  - New Pascua Reservation (Southwest of Tucson)
  - Old Pascua City of Tucson
  - Barrio Libra City of South Tucson
  - Marana Northwest of Tucson
  - Guadalupe Southeast Suburb of Phoenix
- Reservation: Resides on 2,256 acres near Tucson,
- Approximately: 60 miles north of U.S.-Mexican Border (Native American Advancement, Initiatives & Research, 2023)
