- ☐ 61 participants began the ride
 - 18 identified as Veterans
 - 15 identified as non-Veterans
 - 10 did not identify as either Veteran or non-Veteran
 - 18 participants did not return a score card
- **☐** Survey Results:
 - 100% of participants said they would participate in a similar event next year
 - 71% of participants said they learned "a great deal, while the remainder said they learned "some" about helping Veterans in crisis
 - 92% of participants said they "really enjoyed" the ride route and the planned stops, the remainder said the ride route and planned stops "could use some improvement"
