The support line is answered by the dedicated Be Connected Team, who are available to connect callers to information and resources for your food or nutrition needs. Arizona Food Bank Network (AzFBN) - This is a private, non-profit organization serving five regional food bank members and almost 1,000 food pantries and agencies, working to address hunger in all 15 counties of Arizona. They are not a food bank, but they support food banks, collaborating with them and government agencies, community organizations, schools, and other partners to create a hunger-free Arizona.
